

Cancer Research Trust Charter

We aim to make an internationally significant contribution to the development of cures for cancer.

To this end, the Trust:

- will always act with integrity and will only support activities of the highest ethical standards;
- will operate as a not-for-profit entity with deductible gift recipient status subject to annual audit, and its Board members will act in an honorary capacity;
- will make grants to fund world class research into the cures for cancer and related education;
- will only fund innovative work and will work collaboratively with others; and
- will achieve its aims by supporting those with demonstrated excellence, rather than by doing the research itself.

From a financial perspective:

- we will work collaboratively and not competitively with other cancer research entities;
- we will maintain the capital of the trust in real terms year on year; and
- all grants will be made in terms of best practice guidelines of the National Health and Medical Research Council of Australia.
